

Redwood 4-H Meeting Attendance and Participation Advisory

Star Ranks- Bronze, Silver, Gold and Platinum- are awarded to members who accumulate sufficient points in different categories. **In order to be considered for a Star Rank, the member must fully complete the 4-H Record Book**, which includes both the personal development report and project report(s) for any completed project(s). The member must complete at least one project to be a member in good standing.

Record book completion requires 80 % attendance at both the project meetings and at the community club meetings.

Redwood 4-H also has discretion over who shows as Redwood 4-H at the Alameda County Fair. Redwood 4-H is therefore requesting 80 % attendance at BOTH project meetings and community club meetings. Redwood 4-H is also requesting that each youth member attend:

- One of the two Dunsmuir Petting Zoos- December or April
- One additional community service/outreach event
- One fundraising event

Redwood 4-H is also requesting that each parent/guardian agree to:

- Serve as a club level leader or coordinate/co-coordinate one event – community service, outreach or fundraising – and –
- Attend one other event
